RICHARD O'SULLIVAN TO KEYNOTE AT NATIONAL HEALTHCARE MEETING

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(Arnold, MD) Richard O'Sullivan, principal of <u>Change Management Solutions</u>, will deliver the closing keynote address at the Medical Transcription Industry Association's 21st Annual Conference on April 30, 2010 in Daytona Beach, FL. The address, entitled *Finding Opportunity in the Post-Recession Economy without Fear* will examine how the causes of the recession and the drivers of the recovery are changing healthcare delivery and, in turn, creating new opportunities for medical transcription services providers.
